Popular Items to Barter

Bottled Water
Water Purification supplies
Food
Precious Metals / Coins / Jewelry
Coffee And Tea
Honey (tremendous medicinal value as well as a natural sweetener)
High-proof alcohol (medicinal value as well as a comfort item)
Cigarettes! (a purely comfort item that commands a premium)
Hand Sanitizer
Personal care products (deodorant / lotion / perfume / bar soap / shampoo / Vaseline etc.)
Toilet Paper and Baby Wipes (Baby Wipes are hugely versatile)
Feminine Hygiene products
First Aid Kit (include Iodine / Witch Hazel / Rubbing Alcohol / Hydrogen Peroxide)
Medical Supplies (bandages / gauze / Vaseline, etc.)
Antibiotics / Pain Meds / Nausea & Antidiarrheals / Cold & Flu meds, etc.
Fire-starting supplies (lighters / matches / charcoal / wood / Butane / Propane / Alcohol)
Fishing and hunting supplies
Blankets
Emergency Blankets (several dozen, at least)
Shoes and Clothing (including hats / gloves & mittens / scarves / socks)
Sewing supplies
Books (survival books as well as general topic books)
Toys & Games
A decent set of hand tools
Zip Ties and Bungee Cords (multiples in various sizes)
Rope (paracord / twine / nylon rope)
Cheap Flashlights (barter batteries separately!)
Glue (Super Glue / Wood Glue / other heavy-duty glues for daily repair uses)
Tape (Duct / Electrical / Painter's / Packing)
Black Trash Bags (hugely versatile and an essential for daily living)
Unscented Bleach (use for water purification & sanitation)
Batteries (AAA / AA / C / D / 9V / Specialty)

Tips!

- 1. Your knowledge and skills are the most valuable assets you possess.
- 2. Your presence is invaluable. Use it wisely.
- 3. Only barter the items you can safely and comfortably live without.
- 4. Agree in advance on the fair value of the goods and services being traded.
- 5. Be creative: trade a cooked meal or food for a day's work!
- 6. Never attempt to barter worthless items. You risk being kicked out of the group or worse.
- 7. Never attempt to cheat others- the situation is already dangerous!
- 8. Bartering or attempting to barter illegal street drugs and pharmaceutical narcotics is dangerous and could make you a target.
- 9. The same goes for large caches of weapons and military-grade equipment. Tread lightly.
- 10. Consider temporarily loaning items such as a small generator, charging cables or other high value items to trusted friends and family in exchange for labor or handyman services.
